The purpose of this class is to teach you and your canine partner the practical steps required to be able to conduct an effective water search for a submerged human body from shore and from a watercraft. This seminar will include fieldwork along shoreline and in watercraft prior to evaluations.

The above curriculum is subject to change based on the needs of class. Students should be prepared to work in various weather conditions.

Evaluations will be offered on the last day of class and the instructors reserve the right to recommend which canine teams are ready to test.
